



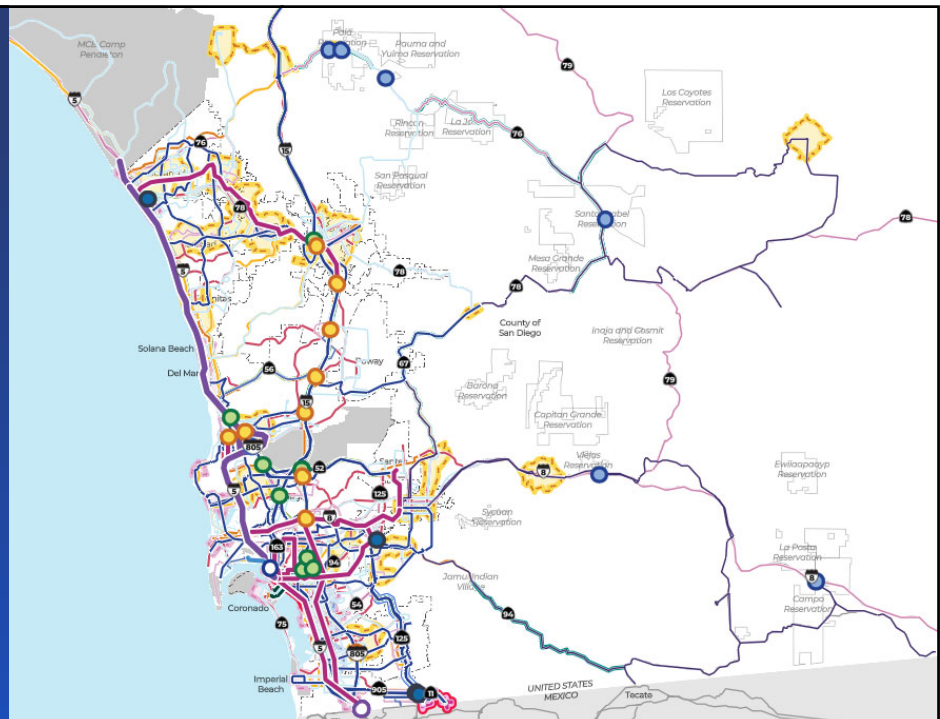

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


Draft 2025 Regional Plan Transportation Network

- 35 new Rapid routes by 2035
- Upgrading service on existing transit routes
- More rural transit service
- 36 neighborhood shuttle service areas, including services in rural communities
- Complete network of Managed Lanes to improve traffic flow

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Draft 2025 Regional Plan Outreach Summary



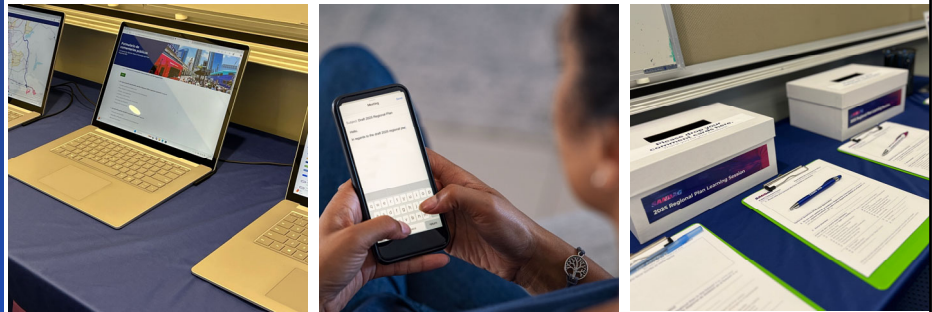
- Five learning sessions (four in-person and one virtual)
- 24 Presentations to stakeholder groups across the region
- 44+ CBO pop-ups at community events across the region
- Notifications emails to the regional and local stakeholders, including city staff and elected officials, about the Draft Plan release and upcoming learning sessions.
- Media advisories about the Draft Plan and learning sessions
- Social media ads promoting the learning sessions and online comment tool

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Public Comment Received

- 421 Total Comments, most received by:
 - 87% Online form
 - 9% Learning Sessions
 - 3% Email



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Public Comment Feedback Common Themes

What we heard from public comments:

- **Mode-specific**
 - Transit routes, bikeways, and managed lanes (support and concerns)
 - Increased frequency on transit lines
- **Safety**
 - Roadway safety for pedestrians and bike users
- **Climate**
 - Address climate issues, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and improve air quality.
- **Housing**
 - Concerns about affordable housing and encouraging dense development around transit
- **Project Specific**
 - Purple Line, LOSSAN corridor, airport transit connection, and the Youth Opportunity Pass program.
