## Resolution No. 2026-06

APPROVING THE PROPOSED FINAL 2025 COORDINATED PUBLIC TRANSIT-  
HUMAN SERVICES TRANSPORTATION PLAN IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE INFRASTRUCTURE  
INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT

WHEREAS, the federal Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) requires that each region prepare a locally developed Coordinated Public Transit – Human Services Transportation Plan (Coordinated Plan); and

WHEREAS, the IIJA includes a requirement that projects selected for funding under the Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities (Section 5310) Program be included in the Coordinated Plan; and

WHEREAS, the IIJA requires the Coordinated Plan to be developed and approved through a process that included participation by seniors, individuals with disabilities, representatives of public, private, nonprofit transportation and human service providers, and other members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Association of Governments scheduled a public hearing on December 05, 2025 at 9 a.m. and gave the public notice and a reasonable opportunity to appear and be heard regarding the approval of the 2025 Coordinated Plan;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Transportation Committee approves the 2025 Coordinated Plan.
