### Approving the Revised Allocation of FY 2026 Transportation Development Act Funds Article 4.5 Community Transit Service

WHEREAS, the Transportation Development Act (TDA) claimants listed below have submitted claims amendment for FY 2026 TDA funds pursuant to Chapter 4, Article 4.5, of the Public Utilities Code (PUC); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29532 of the Government Code (GC), the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) has analyzed the revised claims and determined that the claims conform substantially to the provisions of the TDA of 1971, as amended, including the provision of PUC 99275.5; and
