SSTAC Membership Update and Solicitation of Volunteers

Overview

Per the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC) Charter, SSTAC members ordinarily serve a three-year term beginning and ending in the month of July. The Charter requires that some seats be filled by certain types of agencies to achieve broad representation and fulfill the requirements of PUC Section 99238. A vacancy in one of the seats for a social service provider for people with disabilities has necessitated a special election. SANDAG is soliciting applications to fill this seat. In addition, SANDAG is asking for up to three current SSTAC members to serve on a selection panel for this vacant seat.

Staff will present details on the Social Services Transportation Advisory Council (SSTAC) membership and application process, identify opportunities to serve on the SSTAC, and solicit volunteers for the selection panel.

Key Considerations

A local agency was selected to fill one of the seats for a social service provider for people with disabilities in 2024, with a three-year term expiring in 2027. The agency was later consolidated under Jewish Family Service of San Diego, which is already serving on the SSTAC as a social service provider for people of limited means. This change vacates a seat for a social service provider for people with disabilities. To continue the staggering of SSTAC member three-year terms, we are looking to fill this seat for the remaining two years, with a term expiring in July 2027.

Next Steps

We are seeking applications for an agency to serve as a social service provider for people with disabilities. The application period will be from September 16 through October 17, and the selection committee will meet in the second half of October. The application is available [online](#) and attached to this report. It will be also distributed to current members, prospective members, and other specialized transportation stakeholders by email next week. The successful applicants will be contacted and invited to take their seats at the following SSTAC meeting on November 18. We request up to three current SSTAC members who are not applying for reappointment to volunteer to serve on a selection panel.
