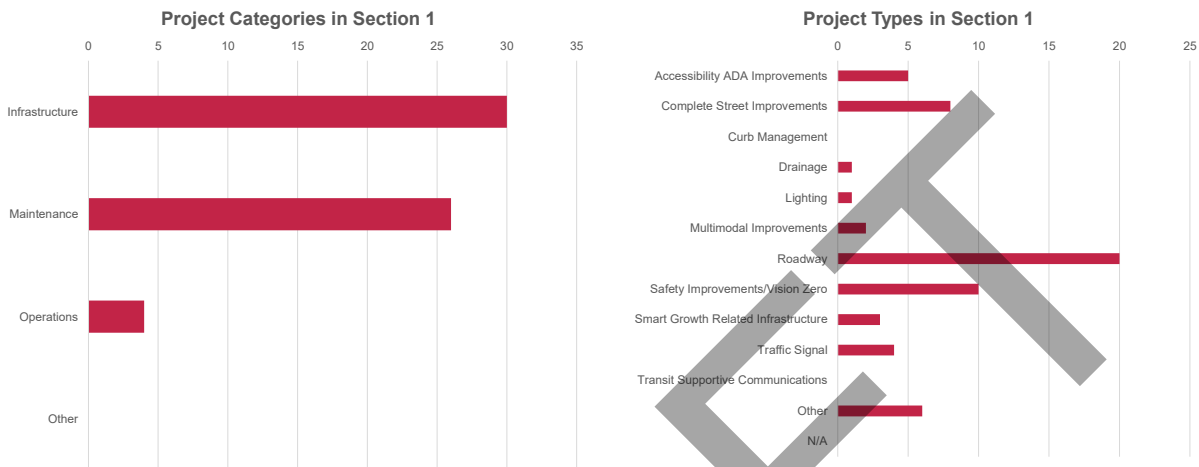

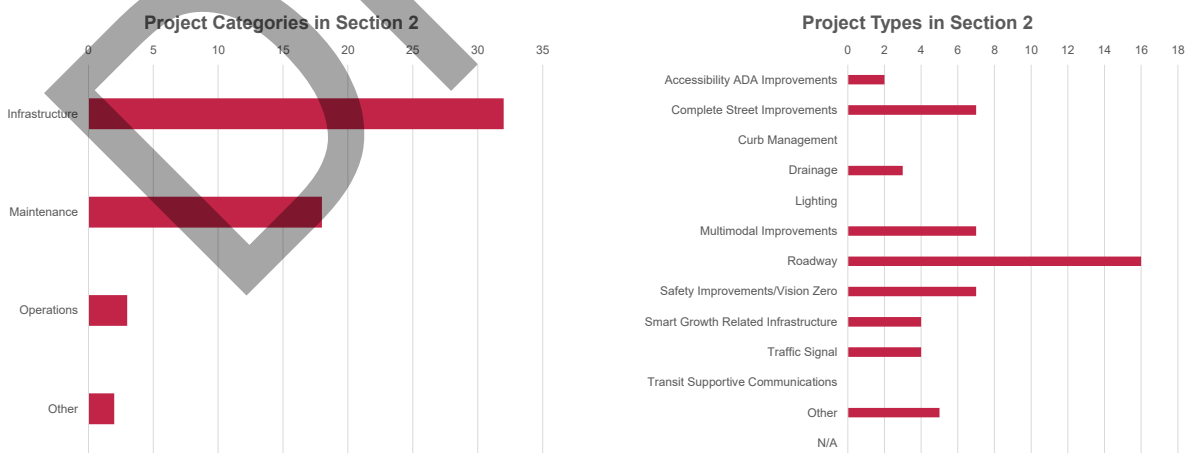
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Section 1 Summary: Projects Completed in FY 24

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Concerns/Challenges

- Staffing, including turnover and capacity
- Loss of institutional knowledge w/ regard to TransNet Program
- Has taken significant time for current staff to learn TransNet program
- Issues with Contractors that slowed progress
- Inconsistencies in data collection and presentation
- Inconsistencies across agencies concerning resources
- Higher construction costs and/or bids
- Uncertainty surrounding how U.S. economy will impact projects planned for FY 2025
- Contractors becoming increasingly reluctant to bid on projects burdened with complex regulatory requirements
- Project delays due to various needs

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
