Subject: National City Local *TransNet* Expenditures

Dear Ms. Babaki,

The City of National City relies heavily on local *TransNet* funding to support critical transportation improvement projects that benefit all roadway users. We understand that according to SANDAG's records National City did not meet the minimum use of local *TransNet* funds for FY 2025. The minimum use of funds will be met or exceeded by the end of the Second Quarter of FY 2026 through completion of the following capital projects, which are all currently under construction:

- FY 24 and FY 25 Pavement Rehabilitation (CIP #23-15) - \$3.67 million *TransNet* funds (NC 01)
- FY 24 and FY 25 ADA Improvements (CIP# 24-04) - \$500,000 *TransNet* funds (NC 01)
- Central Community Mobility Enhancements (CIP# 19-23) - \$300,000 *TransNet* funds (NC 01)

These projects were delayed as additional time was needed to complete pavement and sidewalk condition assessments in the field to better inform final design and cost estimates prior to advertising for construction.
