

## Approval of Proposed Contract Awards for Freeway Service Patrol Project

### Overview

Solicitations valued at \$5 million or more are brought to the Board of Directors for approval prior to advertisement and again prior to contract award. There is one action for the Board's consideration.

### Key Considerations

The Board approved the solicitation for a Request for Proposals (RFP) on February 23, 2024 to solicit proposals for qualified and experienced trucking/towing firms to perform Freeway Service Patrol in the region. These services support the alleviation of non-recurrent traffic congestion problems in metropolitan areas within the region by providing a roving patrol service to assist and/or remove disabled vehicles, minor collisions, and debris from urban freeways during peak, midday and weekend commute hours.

The solicitation was advertised on the SANDAG public bidding portal from March 19, 2025 to April 23, 2025. A total of 5 proposals were received. All five proposals met the RFP requirements and were deemed qualified firms for the project. A standard evaluation process was conducted in accordance with Board Policy No. 16 requirements. The Evaluation Committee has recommended awarding contracts to three (3) firms including A to Z Enterprises (dba RoadOne Towing), Angie's Towing (dba Quality Towing and Recovery), and Sunshine Towing.

Contracts are geographically assigned based on operational shifts (Peak, Midday, Weekend) for North and South portions of San Diego County. Each firm will be allocated designated beats, enabling continuous service delivery rather than on-call availability. The only task performed on an on-call basis is the Traffic Mitigation Program, which is initiated upon request by Caltrans. The proposed contracts will allow for a term of five (5) years. The total combined value of the contracts will not exceed the original solicitation value of \$67 million.

### Next Steps

Pending approval by the Board, SANDAG will award contracts to A to Z Enterprises (dba RoadOne Towing), Angie's Towing (dba Quality Towing and Recovery), and Sunshine Towing.

### Fiscal Impact:

The maximum aggregate value of all contracts awarded from this solicitation will not exceed the original solicitation value of \$67 million for the five-year period. Funding will be appropriated annually. This program is funded by a State Grant and through a match provided by Motorist Aid funds for agencies participating in the Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) program. Funding will be derived from Overall Work Program Budgets 3310200, Motorist Aid Services – FSP, and 3312400, FSP – Traffic Mitigation Program.

### Schedule/Scope Impact:

The selected vendors will provide services from FY 2026 through FY 2030.
